This is the species incorrectly introduced by me as British in 1911 (1911. Ent. Month Mag. 47:231) as C. acutipennis Lw. Mr.

Balden found a specimen at the entrance to a rabbit's burrow at Temple (Berks) on Sept. 15th, 1934, and I can record it from Waxham (Norfolk).

There would appear to be differences of specific value in species of Camilla in the extent of microscopic dusting on thorax and abdomen. In the closely allied British species globosa Fln., and fuscipes Coll., the former has the greater part of notopleural depression devoid of dust, and a very small dusted area on third abdominal tergite; whereas in fuscipes nearly all the notopleural depressions are dusted, and there is a large triangular dusted area on third abdominal tergite.
